ac3 Reports \$400K Profit for 2007/08

Sydney, 3 November 2008 – The Australian Centre for Advanced Computing and Communications (**ac3**) today announced revenue of \$AU8.5 million for the 2007/08 financial year, with a profit of \$AU409,000.

This represents a 33% increase in revenue over the previous year, with profit more than doubling. The result is based on an increased demand for managed services, as well as the co-location of computer and networking equipment for clients.

"This is a pleasing result for the company," said **ac3** CEO Philip McCrea. "We now have more than 100 clients who entrust us with their mission critical infrastructure, which we manage around the clock to ensure their systems are 'always on'".

"The biggest growth area has been in managed services, primarily in systems administration including Linux, Windows and Solaris, as well as in database administration".
